Dear Jackson Academy Family,

As I wrote a year ago, my early impressions of Jackson Academy athletics were once again affirmed by the level of commitment clearly exhibited by our players, coaches, families, fans, and students, and I believe more than ever that a vibrant athletic program is a prime indicator of the health of a successful and balanced school.

Independent schools across the country continue to seek ways to distinguish themselves and offer programs outside of the classroom that help develop their students into positive contributors to the society in which they will live. Athletics is one such opportunity, and what was once spoken of as an "extracurricular" activity is more and more appropriately becoming known as a "cocurricular" activity. Athletics does not stand alone as an entity unto itself, but instead one that supports and complements those things learned in the classroom or on the stage or in the home. Moreover, athletic competition is not simply about win-loss records or championships, but far more about being part of

something bigger than one's self, about learning to deal with disappointments as well as successes, and about a young person accomplishing personal goals he or she may not previously have thought possible.

Perhaps unique to athletics, is the recognition that both successes and disappointments are claimed and held in memory by the entire student body and greater school community, not just the participants. Forever in a former student's reminiscence, whether or not a team member, "we" is consistently used to reference a championship or a hard-fought defeat of a traditional rival. Conversely, "we" is also used to share in a heartbreaking loss.

A successful athletic program is not attained simply through the players, coaches, and facilities. It is also critically dependent upon the tireless support of the families and fans in our school, most notably from the Jackson Academy Athletic Booster Club. I again wholeheartedly thank the Booster Club for its continued indispensable and tireless dedication in support of our youth. And I continue to encourage all parents to likewise offer their time and talents to help insure our athletic program's success, not measured simply by wins and losses, but even more so by the permanent character values it instills in our young men and women.

Strength and Conditioning Coach



ALAN WHITFIELD PT, DPT, ATC, LAT


Doctor of Physical Therapy/Athletic Trainer Director of Rehabilitation Services at MS Sports Medicine and Orthopedic Center
