Looking Back — Moving Forward

Recognizing the need for a more personal approach to education a group of parents met on May 18, 1959 to organize a school that would become Jackson Academy. On May 29, 1959 the charter was granted and in September, 1959 the school first opened its doors to about 40 pupils in a duplex on Northview Drive. Mr. Loyal M. Bearss was the first headmaster.

The present site on Ridgewood Road was purchased in 1963 and the first school year here was 1963-64. A classroom annex behind the original building was added in 1964. A pre-school addition on the south end of the main building was constructed in 1966.

Mr. Ray R. Stevens became headmaster in 1966 and in 1967 Jackson Academy was recognized as fully accredited.

An enrollment that almost doubled in 1970 required an expansion in staff and an addition of an upper elementary building and our present junior high building. This had been under study since 1965. Care was taken to insure that the distinctive characteristics of Jackson Academy's instruction and curriculum were not relinquished. Initial resources were committed to academics—the primary function of a school—guaranteeing those attending with a superior education.

Continued growth necessitated a new pre-

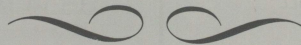
school building in 1972 for the four and five year old program at Jackson Academy.

In 1975, Mr. Glenn A. Cain assumed the duties as headmaster. A long needed and eagerly awaited activities building was added in 1977. This greatly enhanced the physical education and athletic programs. Jackson Academy could now be a real contender in interscholastic competition.

The infamous "Flood of 1979" damaged property but not spirit. The whole school was brought closer together figuratively and literally as all worked to restore Jackson Academy.

The year 1980-81 brings with it the fulfillment of a fifteen year old dream. After careful consideration and planning, Jackson Academy's administration and Board made the decision to add the tenth and eleventh grades. This decision was based on a study that revealed a real need for an additional high school facility in the private educational community. A challenging curriculum for students capable of average to superior performance will be offered to a student body of 950 by 80 experienced staff members.

This brief history of Jackson Academy has shown its expansion in terms of physical plant, yet the school is much more than bricks, mortar, and classrooms—it is an institution dedicated to development of true learning, moral character, and good citizenship.
