

The primary concern of Jackson Academy's Board of Trustees and Administration is to provide for the diverse interests and goals of all the students.

## Varsity Football

The 1990 Football Season sets JA in a very challenging position. First we gave an eleven game schedule; second we play six new high schools; third, we play five top teams in our divisions, two of them finishing number 1, Parklane and number two, Jackson Prep.

I would say that is a challenge!

Since our last game of 1989, our returning players, our JV squad that moved up and several new prospects have given us good depth at all positions.


We had a good spring practice, a good off season strength and conditioning program, therefore, I believe our players are showing they want to improve, and I expect them to do just that, improve.

Our football program, therefore, believes in a sound strength training philosophy that when followed will develop our student athletes to their fullest potential as they continue to mature physically.


