


Dear Friends:

### **Jackson Academy Raider Band**

The Jackson Academy Band Program, in its fifth year under the direction of Bruce Carter, is composed of the Marching Band, the Pep Band, the Concert Band, and the Jazz Band. During the fall, the Marching Band supports the varsity football team at pep rallies and football games, while the Pep Band supports the Junior High Raiders. In 1992, the Marching Band won several individual awards and captured the Best of Class A at the Heart of Dixie Marching Festival in Prattville, Alabama. The Band also competed at the Bands of America Southern Regional competition held at USM, and captured Division I Championship and Sixth Place Overall, qualifying them to compete this year at the Bands of America Grand National Championships in Indianapolis on November 13th. The Band will also compete in the Bands of America Southern Regionals in Atlanta in October.

In February 1993, the Concert Band was the only Mississippi High School Band invited to perform at the 37th Annual Southern Instrumental Conductors Conference at the University of Southern Mississippi.

The Concert and Jazz Bands participated in the All-American Music Festival in Nashville in April, where both groups were awarded a gold medal. and the Concert Band brought home the Sweepstakes Award for the highest score of the day.

Individual band members also participated in many clinics during the past year including the Mid South Honor Band at Ole Miss, the Delta State Honor Band, MPSA Band Clinic, and the Mississippi State Music Camp.

Six Jackson Academy Band members auditioned and were selected to be a part of the 1993 Mississippi Lions All-State Band which placed 1st in International Competition in a field of 138 bands in Minneapolis in July, J.A. members of the 1993 Lions Band were Angie Haggard, Dancer; Nathan Nix, Trombone; Nick Mayfield, Percussion; Jeffrey Cadle, Tuba; Mark Ellis, Clarinet; and Marty Newcomb, Trumpet.






