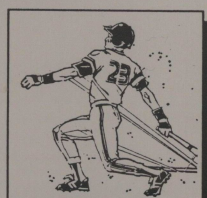
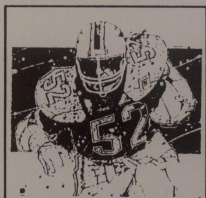

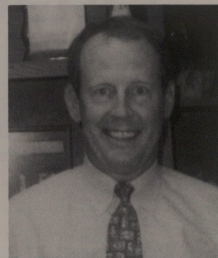

Jackson Academy considers it a privilege to have you visit our campus for athletic events. We also invite you to attend and support other JA activities that involve our fine student body.

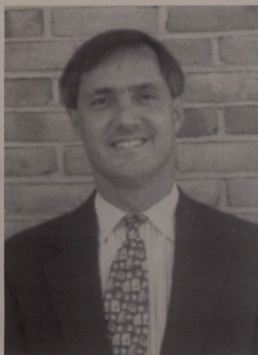

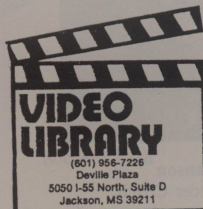
## Tennis

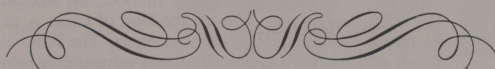
