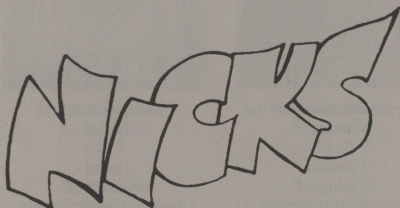
1995-97 Varsity Girls Basketball
