Jackson Academy was established in 1959 as an independent day school. It was created for and is dedicated to the education of boys and girls, preschool through senior high.

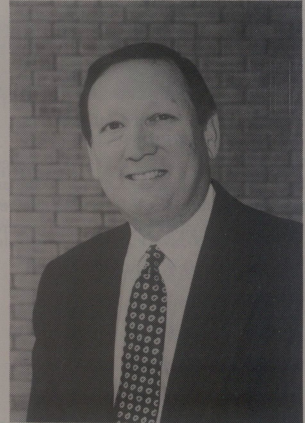
Through the diligent and unselfish efforts of many people, the school has grown to include a thirty-eight acre campus serving approximately 1500 students with a faculty and staff of 160.

Jackson Academy considers it a privilege to have you visit our campus for athletic events. We also invite you to attend and support other JA activities that involve our fine student body.



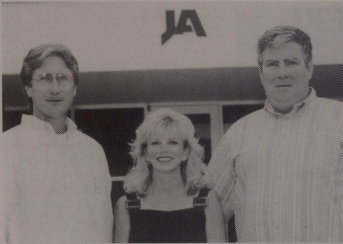

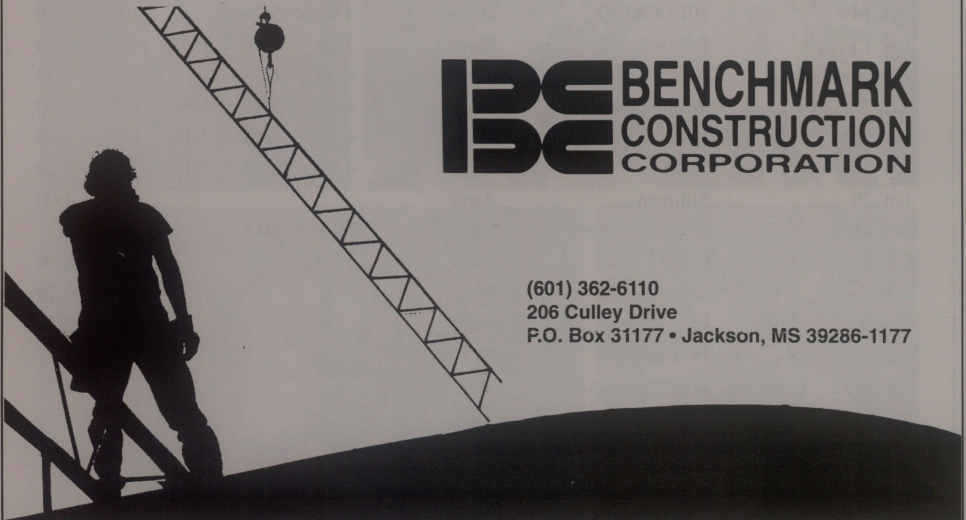


## A COACH'S PRAYER

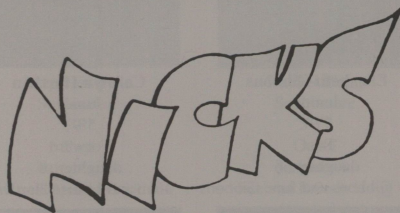
## ***Jackson Academy Varsity Girls Basketball***

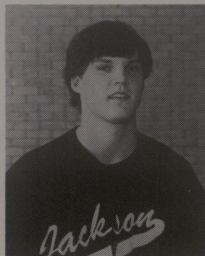

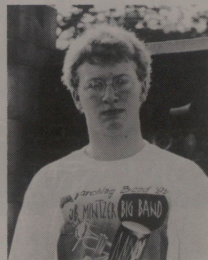
## JA Band

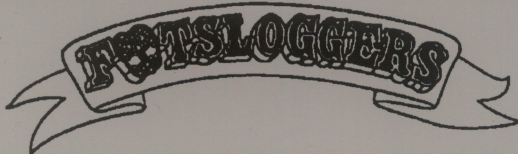
