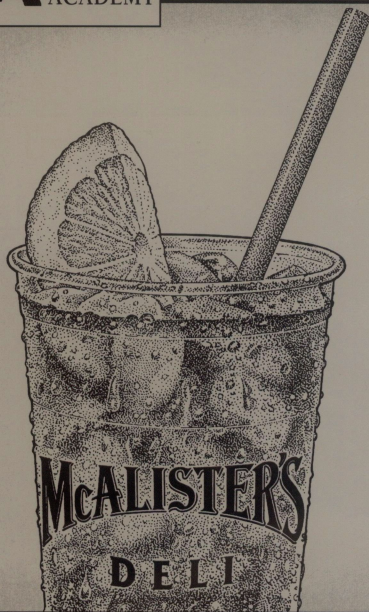



Jackson Academy was established in 1959 as an independent day school. It was created for and is dedicated to the education of boys and girls, preschool through senior high.

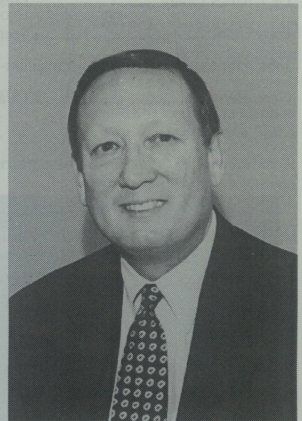
Through the diligent and unselfish efforts of many people, the school has grown to include a thirty-eight acre campus serving approximately 1500 students with a faculty and staff of 170.

We're excited about the 2000 team and hope to carry on the tradition of winning at Jackson Academy.

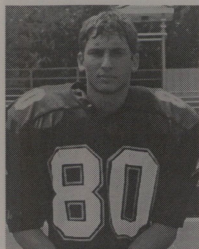

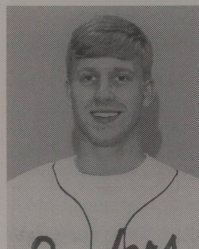
The 2000 Raider baseball season proved to be one of excitement, with many games coming down to the final pitch. Numerous young players earned starting roles and gained experience with each game.

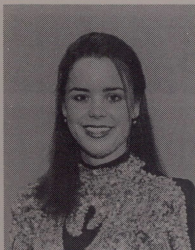

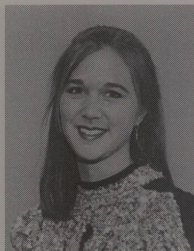
## *Accents*

### 2000 Jackson Academy Marching Band

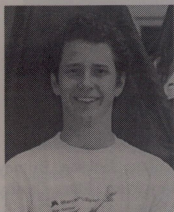

In 1998 the Band won the Class A Championship at the BOA St. Louis Regional Competition in the TWA Dome.
