# Varsity Strength and Conditioning

During the spring of this year, the program's overall focus was improving the athletes' strength with emphasis on flexibility and power. In varsity football, each player not involved in spring sports is given a nine-week cycle of weight room training and running drills from December until May. The athletes are measured in the bench. squat, and clean for football and incline bench and leg press for basketball. Coach Sojourner and Coach Ball have done a great job working with
