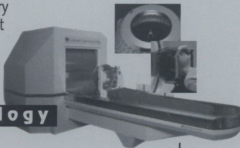

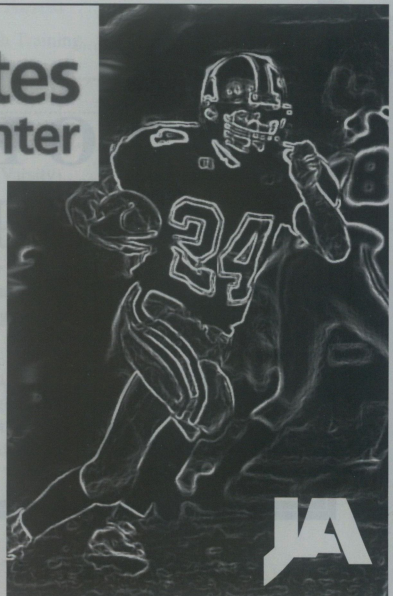

Through the diligent and unselfish efforts of many people, the school has grown to include a thirty-eight acre campus serving approximately 1510 students with a faculty and staff of 175.


