Boo Ferris Influence Award

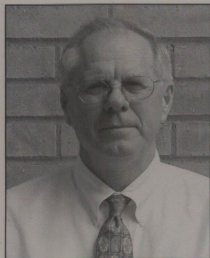

All Raiders congratulate and thank Trey for doing a fantastic job in such a Christ-like Manner.

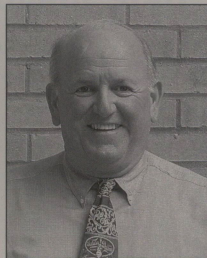
