LETTER FROM THE HEADMASTER

Dear Jackson Academy Family,

Looking back on my first year at Jackson Academy, my early impressions were affirmed by the level of commitment clearly exhibited by the players, coaches, families, fans, and students. As I said a year ago, and still believe, a vibrant athletic program is a prime indicator of the health of a successful and balanced school.

Independent schools across the country continue to seek ways to distinguish themselves and offer programs outside of the classroom that help develop their students into positive contributors to the society in which they will live. Athletics is one such opportunity, and what was once spoken of as an “extra-curricular” activity is more and more appropriately becoming a “co-curricular” activity. Athletics does not stand alone as an entity unto itself, but instead one that supports and compliments those things learned in the classroom or on the stage. And athletic competition is not simply about win-loss records or championships, but more about being part of something bigger than one’s self, about learning to deal with elation as well as disappointment, and about a young person accomplishing personal goals he or she may not previously have thought possible.

A successful athletic program is not attained simply through the players, coaches and facilities. It is also critically dependent upon the tireless support of the families and fans in our school, most notably from the Jackson Academy Athletic Booster Club. I wholeheartedly thank the Booster Club for its continued invaluable and tireless dedication in support of our youth. And I encourage all parents to likewise offer your time and talents to help insure the program’s success, not measured simply by wins and losses but even more so by the character values it instills in our young men and women.

After leaving MC, Brooks stayed in the Jackson area, coaching one season at Jackson Prep before spending two seasons as an assistant to Kenny Bizot at Hillcrest Christian. Brooks helped lead the Cougars to an Overall State Championship in his first season on the bench. Brooks then moved to the college coaching ranks as an assistant at Belhaven where he spent two seasons. In 2004, Brooks took the head coaching job at Hernando High School in north Mississippi. In his first season, Brooks led the Tigers to a 10-15 record, a notable improvement over previous seasons at the school. Brooks then led Hernando to three seasons with records over .500, culminating in a 28-7 record and a trip to the 4A North State Tournament in 2007-08. In his ten seasons with the Choctaws, MC advanced to the American Southwest Conference Tournament all six years they were a part of the ASC. The 2012-13 season saw the Choctaws land Brandon Blake on the All-ASC First Team and the D3hoops.com All-South Region Team. In the 2008-09 season, Brooks helped lead the Choctaws to a 20-7 overall record and an appearance in the American Southwest Conference Tournament Championship Game. Coach Brooks then helped see the Choctaws through their 3-year transition from NCAA Division III Athletics to Division II Athletics. Brooks graduated from MC in 1999. Josh is married to the former Marie McDade, who graduated from MC in 2001. Josh and Marie have two children: Avery and Mallory. Marie works in the JA Admissions Department.

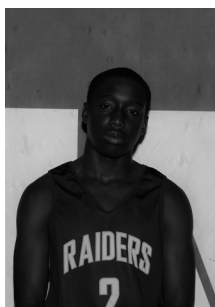


2018-19 JR. HIGH BOYS BASKETBALL

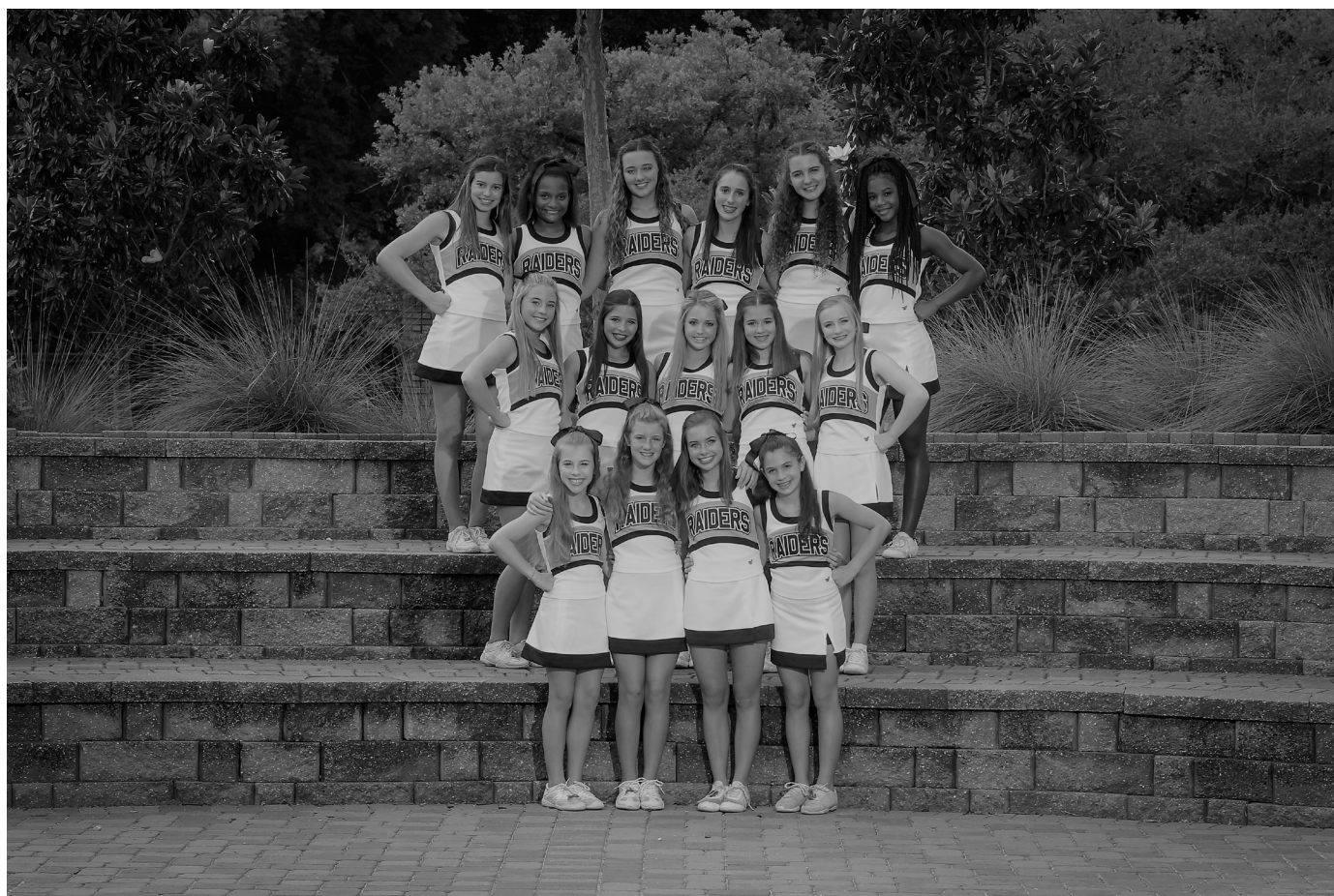


2018-19 VARSITY CHEER
