

Head Varsity Boys Basketball Coach

Coach Brooks is beginning his third season as head coach for the boys basketball team at Jackson Academy. In his first two seasons at JA, the Raiders achieved a record of 44-25 and made a trip to the semi-finals of the Overall Tournament. Prior to JA, Coach Brooks served as an Assistant Coach for the men's basketball team at Mississippi College. In his ten seasons with the Choctaws, MC advanced to the American Southwest Conference Tournament all six years they were a part of the ASC. The 2012-13 season saw the Choctaws land Brandon Blake on the All-ASC First Team and the D3hoops. com All-South Region Team. In the 2008-09 season, Brooks helped lead the Choctaws to a 20-7 overall record and an appearance in the American Southwest Conference Tournament Championship Game. Coach Brooks then helped see the Choctaws through their 3-year transition from NCAA Division III Athletics to Division II Athletics. Prior to MC, Brooks was the head coach at Hernando High School in North Mississippi. In his first season, Brooks led the Tigers to a 11-13 record, a notable improvement over previous seasons at the school. Brooks then led Hernando to three seasons with records over .500, culminating in a 28-7 record and a trip to the 4A North State Tournament in 2007-08. In five seasons as a high school head coach Coach Brooks has a 98-54 record. Brooks graduated from MC in 1999. Josh is married to the former Marie McDade, who graduated from MC in 2001. Josh and Marie have two children: Avery and Mallory. Marie works in the JA Admissions Department.



#### PHILLIP BUFFINGTON
