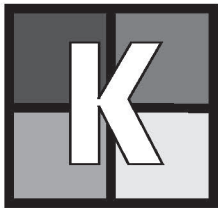

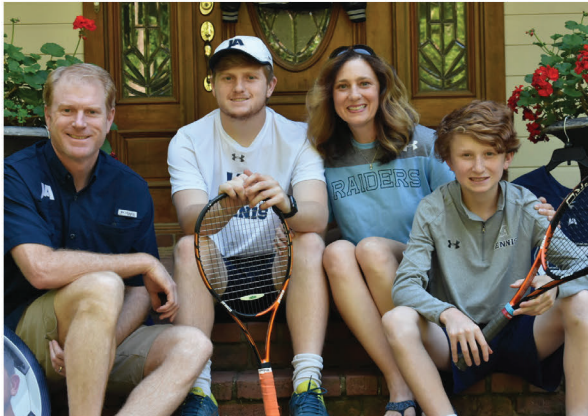

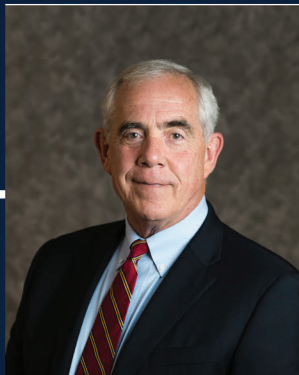

## BROCK ANGLE

*Head Girls Track Coach, Assistant Football Coach*

Coach Angle is beginning his 18th year at Jackson Academy and 38th year coaching overall. Brock came to JA after serving two years at Lamar School in Meridian. Brock enters his sixth year as girls track head coach. Coach Angle served as head football coach at French Camp Academy for three seasons. He is a graduate of French Camp Academy and Mississippi State University.



## TREY BAYLISS

*Varsity Assistant Football Coach, Assistant Baseball Coach*

Coach Bayliss is entering his third year at Jackson Academy after ten years of service at East Rankin Academy and nine years prior at Jackson Prep. He is a graduate of Jackson Prep and Belhaven University. During Coach Bayliss's time at East Rankin, he held multiple coaching, teaching, and administrative positions, including head coach of the baseball, football, and softball teams. Additionally, he served as an Administrative Assistant and Athletic Director. While at Jackson Prep, Coach Bayliss was the head coach for the junior high football team and served as an assistant on the varsity staff. As head baseball coach from 2001-2006, Bayliss won state championships in 2003, 2004, and 2005. Coach Bayliss's honors include: MAIS Baseball Coach of the Year in 2003, 2004, and 2005; All Metro Coach of the Year 2003; plus he received All Conference Coach of the Year honors in both football and baseball. Coach Bayliss has three children: Katie, Sarah, and Tyler.



## JOSH BROOKS

*Head Varsity Boys Basketball Coach*

Coach Brooks is beginning his third season as head coach for the boys basketball team at Jackson Academy. In his first two seasons at JA, the Raiders achieved a record of 44-25 and made a trip to the semi-finals of the Overall Tournament. Prior to JA, Coach Brooks served as an Assistant Coach for the men's basketball team at Mississippi College. In his ten seasons with the Choctaws, MC advanced to the American Southwest Conference Tournament all six years they were a part of the ASC. The 2012-13 season saw the Choctaws land Brandon Blake on the All-ASC First Team and the D3hoops.com All-South Region Team. In the 2008-09 season, Brooks helped lead the Choctaws to a 20-7 overall record and an appearance in the American Southwest Conference Tournament Championship Game. Coach Brooks then helped see the Choctaws through their 3-year transition from NCAA Division III Athletics to Division II Athletics. Prior to MC, Brooks was the head coach at Hernando High School in North Mississippi. In his first season, Brooks led the Tigers to a 11-13 record, a notable improvement over previous seasons at the school. Brooks then led Hernando to three seasons with records over .500, culminating in a 28-7 record and a trip to the 4A North State Tournament in 2007-08. In five seasons as a high school head coach Coach Brooks has a 98-54 record. Brooks graduated from MC in 1999. Josh is married to the former Marie McDade, who graduated from MC in 2001. Josh and Marie have two children: Avery and Mallory. Marie works in the JA Admissions Department.



## PHILLIP BUFFINGTON

*Head Varsity Boys Soccer Coach, Head Varsity Girls Soccer Coach, Assistant Track Coach*

Coach Buffington begins his fifth season at Jackson Academy and his second as the head boys and girls varsity soccer coach this year. Phillip came to JA after serving four years as head varsity soccer coach at Manchester Academy. Phillip has also been coaching six years at Mississippi Rush Soccer Club in addition to JA. Phillip holds a US Soccer C license as well as a USC Advanced National coaching diploma. Coach Buffington attended Marshall University as a freshman in 2005 and Mississippi College from 2006-2008 playing as a member of the soccer program for both schools. In 2009, Buffington signed a professional contract with Harrisburg City Islanders, now Penn FC of the USL PRO league. He spent two seasons at Harrisburg and one year in Australia playing soccer professionally before moving back to Jackson and starting his coaching career. *Head Varsity Girls Basketball Coach*

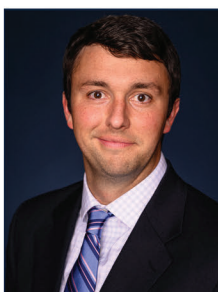
