


## CODE OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP


- •Total team effort.





**BROCK ANGLE** 

Head Girls Track Coach, Assistant Football Coach

Coach Angle enters his 19th year at Jackson Academy and 39th year coaching overall. He begins his sixth year as girls track head coach. Angle came to JA after coaching two years at Lamar School in Meridian. He served as head football coach at French Camp Academy for three seasons. He is a graduate of French Camp Academy and Mississippi State University.



**JOSH BROOKS** 

Head Varsity Boys Basketball Coach

Coach Brooks begins his fourth season as boys basketball head coach. In his first three seasons at JA, the Raiders achieved an impressive 64-34 record. His teams have qualified for the MAIS Overall Tournament twice, reaching the Final 4 and the Final 8. Prior to JA, Coach Brooks served as an assistant coach for the men's basketball program at Mississippi College. In his 10 seasons with the Choctaws, MC advanced to the American Southwest Conference Tournament every year they were a member of the ASC. Prior to MC, Brooks was the head coach at Hernando High School in north Mississippi. In his first season, Brooks led the Tigers to a 11-13 record, a notable improvement over previous seasons at the school. Brooks then led Hernando to three seasons with records over .500, culminating in a 28-7 record and a trip to the 4A North State Tournament in 2007-08. In five seasons as a high school head coach, Coach Brooks posted a 98-54 record. Brooks graduated from MC in 1999. He is married to Marie, who also works at JA in the Admissions office. They have two children at JA: Avery (11th) and Mallory (10th).





Head Varsity Boys Soccer Coach, Head Varsity Girls Soccer Coach, Assistant Track Coach

Coach Buffington scores his sixth season at Jackson Academy and his third as the head boys and girls varsity soccer coach. Buffington came to JA after serving four years as head varsity soccer coach at Manchester Academy. He also has been coaching six years at Mississippi Rush Soccer Club in addition to JA. He holds a US Soccer C license as well as a USC Advanced National coaching diploma. Coach Buffington attended Marshall University as a freshman in 2005 and Mississippi College from 2006-2008, playing as a member of the soccer program for both schools. In 2009, Buffington signed a professional contract with Harrisburg City Islanders, now Penn FC of the USL PRO league. He spent two seasons at Harrisburg and one year in Australia playing soccer professionally before moving back to Jackson and beginning his coaching career.
