On April 18, 1942 a plane took off from an aircraft carrier in the Pacific Ocean on a mission with a specific goal in mind, not knowing what their actual final destination would be. In 1959 the Jackson Academy student body adopted its nickname for their new school to honor these selfless acts of commitment to a mission. These 1942 Doolittle Raiders changed the course of our history. They believed in their mission and their country. Like the Doolittle Raiders, the JA Raiders believe in their mission and their school. We do not know the ultimate destination in our lives, but we do know that this journey together at JA will prepare our students for the vast unknowns that certainly lie ahead. Courage to commit to something bigger than self is a noble trait we hope to instill in our student athletes.

Recently I saw a student I coached in the 1980's that I had not seen in decades. Currently a professor in Tennessee in athletic administration, he wanted me to know that I had an impact on his life. I was shocked and humbled. He said that when asked what it would take to make the basketball team, I told those trying out to dive for the ball, take a charge, and rebound others missed shots. He took my approach to coaching to heart, not in the sense of hustle wins games (although it does) but his belief in a team, and that the only way to be your best self is in the context of helping others be their best selves. This is what being a part of a team is about. Someone I have not seen in over thirty years reminded me of the impact that each of us have and our individual responsibilities.

If we hang our hat on winning, which we love to do, we may not come out on top all of the time. If we hang our hat on our culture and our desire to represent ourselves, and our team, family, school, and Lord with our best attitude and skills we possess, we will never lose.

Our students are at JA to learn math, English, science, dance, music, and a host of other subjects. While content at any level is important, the skills we learn along the way are what will best determine our life trajectory. The athletic lab hopes to accomplish the same thing we expect in our classrooms. We want to use plays and schemes and other tools to help us acquire the skills that will help us be better employees, colleagues, bosses, and all around citizens. I hope when you see our Raiders play you see hope for our future in our student athletes. May we all exemplify to those we compete against and our community our appreciation that Jackson Academy is a place that understands that it does matter why and how you play the game.

AUBREY BLACKWELL

Head Varsity Football Coach

Coach Blackwell is beginning his first season at Jackson Academy and his 8th season as a Head Football Coach. Aubrey's career coaching record is 57-26 with 3 region championships and 1 State-Runner Up. During his 6 year run at Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School, the Knights were 54-19, overcoming a 15-44 record their previous 6 years before Aubrey took over. He's helped 36 players achieve scholarships to the next level. He was named to the Robert E. Lee Hall of Fame (2019), the University of Montevallo Hall of Fame (2019), UM Alumni of the Year (2016), The AHSAA 4A Coach of the Year (2017), the Montgomery QB Club Coach of the Year (2017), the CCC Coach of the Year (2017, 2019, 2020), and Coach the AHSAA's South All-Star Team in 2018. Before Montgomery Catholic, he spent two years as the Assistant Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator at Saint James School for his mentor, Jimmy Perry. He helped the Trojans win their first region championship in school history. During his 3 years at Saint Paul's Episcopal School in Mobile, AL, the Saints won the region championship every year, as well as a Semi-Final and Quarterfinal playoff appearance. Prior to coaching high school football, Aubrey coached NCAA Division 1 and Division 2 baseball at Campbell University and the University of Montevallo for 6 seasons as the program's pitching coach. Aubrey is a graduate of the University of Montevallo (BS and MS). He met his wife of 15 years, Brandi, at the University of Montevallo where she played basketball and volleyball. Their children are Will (Class of 2029) and Kayla (Class of 2030).



MICHAEL BRINSON

Head Strength and Conditioning Coach

Coach Brinson is entering his first season as the head strength and conditioning coach for Jackson Academy athletics. Prior to Jackson Academy, Michael served as a strength and conditioning coach for the US Army 82nd airborne division. He also spent two seasons at the University of Missouri as the associate director of football athletic performance. Before Missouri, Michael was an assistant strength coach for the Liberty University football team, University of Kansas football team, and Southern Miss football and track and field program. He played offensive line at Southern Miss from 2011-2014 where he received his bachelor's in exercise science and masters in sports coaching. Michael is a certified strength and conditioning coach through the NSCA. A Jackson native, Michael attended University Christian School where he played football and ran track.



PHILLIP BUFFINGTON

Head Varsity Boys Soccer Coach, Head Varsity Girls Soccer Coach, and Assistant Track Coach

Coach Buffington begins his 7th season at Jackson Academy and his fourth as the Head Boys and Girls Varsity Soccer Coach. The Lady Raiders and the Raiders finished as State Champions last year. Phillip came to JA after serving four years as Head Varsity Soccer Coach at Manchester Academy. Phillip has also been coaching for seven years at Mississippi Rush Soccer Club in addition to JA. Phillip holds a US Soccer C license as well as a USC Advanced National Coaching Diploma. Coach Buffington attended Marshall University as a freshman in 2005 and Mississippi College from 2006-2008 as a member of the soccer program for both schools. Phillip in 2009 signed a professional contract with Harrisburg City Islanders, now Penn FC of the USL PRO league. He spent two seasons at Harrisburg and one year in Australia playing soccer professionally before moving back to Jackson and starting his coaching career. He is a graduate of Jackson Prep, Jackson State University (BS), and the University of Florida (MS). Phillip is married to his wife Lauren.



CALEB CANTERBURY

Lower School Physical Education Teacher, Assistant Track Coach, and Assistant Cross Country Coach

Coach Canterbury is entering his 11th year at Jackson Academy. He teaches Lower School Physical Education and coaches Track and Cross Country. Coach Canterbury graduated from the Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania with a bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education and obtained his master's degree in Kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University. Denson served as an assistant coach and head coach at Clinton High School for 7 years. She also is a coach and assistant director at Infinity Volleyball Academy. In 2018 she led the Lady Raiders to the state championship where they finished runner-up. In 2019 she helped the Lady Raiders to the winningest season in school history (43-3) and a state championship. Denson was named 2019 MAIS coach of the year and 2019 Clarion-Ledger Coach of the year. In 2020 the Lady Raiders defended their State Championship with a 29-4 season. The Lady Raiders won the MAIS Division 1 State Title in 2021 as well. Denson has coached the Mississippi Volleyball Gatorade Player of the Year for the last 3 years. She worked for USA Volleyball through the High-Performance Pipeline from 2017-2019. Melissa works in the upper school science department where she teaches Biology II, Kinesiology, and Human Anatomy and Physiology. She is married to Joshua Denson.



TREY DOWNES

Assistant Varsity Football Coach

Coach Downes was born and raised in Montgomery, Alabama. He attended Montgomery Catholic Preparatory School, playing baseball and football under Coach Blackwell, and was a member of Montgomery Catholic's first winning season in 8 years going 8-2 and making the playoffs for the first time. Coach Downes received his B.S. in Kinesiology with a minor in Sport Coaching from Auburn University in 2021. While at Auburn, he was a student assistant for the football team and was a part of the 2017 Auburn SEC West Championship team. After an internship at Benjamin Russell High School in Alex City, Alabama, Coach Downes went to work full time at Benjamin Russell. Coach Downes is beginning his first year at Jackson Academy and is looking forward to being part of a great program.



DAVID DUGGAN

Assistant Varsity Football Coach

David Duggan begins his first season at Jackson Academy, after serving as director of recruiting at Troy University. Before his time at Troy, Duggan served as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Arkansas State University from 2019-2020 where he helped lead the Red Wolves to a Camellia Bowl appearance in the 2019 season. Prior to Arkansas State, Duggan was at Western Michigan from 2016-2018 where he was linebackers coach for all three seasons and the special teams coordinator for his final two. Duggan helped to lead the Broncos to two bowl appearances during his tenure and a Mid-American Conference Championship in 2016. The 2016 Broncos team finished with an undefeated regular season and were ranked as high as 12th in the nation leading to a berth in the Cotton Bowl for that season. The Broncos also made the Idaho Potato Bowl in the 2018 season. Duggan also has two stints at the University of Southern Mississippi from 2013-2016 and 2008-2011 with a stop at University of North Carolina from 2012-2013 sandwiched between them. While at USM, Duggan was linebackers coach every year during both times, special teams coordinator in 2009-2010, co-defensive coordinator in 2011, and was defensive coordinator from 2013-16. Duggan and his wife, Lynne, have two daughters Olivia and Grace.

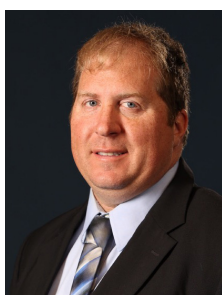

Head Varsity Girls Basketball Coach

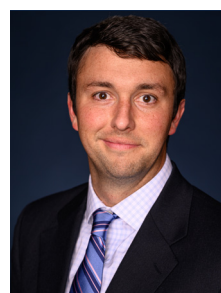
